Deadline to submit: Friday, March 17, 2023

Requirements:

- Be sure to clearly name the School Counselor and the school in your essay.
- ** The School Counselor that you write about can be from any level (High, Middle, or Elementary).
- Follow directions carefully and stay on the identified topic.
- 500 Word Essay; typed.
- DO NOT INCLUDE YOUR NAME in your essay.

Criteria for award:

- Good attendance and good discipline records this school year.
- Quality of written essay (Grammar and Spelling).
- Ability to stay on topic.
- Depth of response; specificity and clear understanding.
- Detailed explanation of how this scholarship will help the student and the student's future education plans.

To help you frame your essay cover the following questions:

1. How did a School Counselor impact your educational/personal or social experience and where you are now?
2. How did this School Counselor help you with your future plans?
3. How will this scholarship help you with your educational plans?
4. How would you like to help others in the future?
