About the Award:

- In the amount of up to \$2000 annually, payable in two installments (half in the fall, the other half in the spring).
- Scholarship is for undergraduate course work only and is renewable for a maximum of three additional years or for a total of eight semesters.

To Qualify for the Award:

- Students must submit an application to the university and be accepted for admission with a declared Theatre Major
- The theatre scholarship recipient must be enrolled at FGCU as a full-time student (12 or more credit hours per semester) and for both the fall and spring semesters of the academic year and maintain an overall grade point average of at least 3.0
- The theatre scholarship recipient must complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)

AUDITION INFORMATION!

FOR ALL STUDENTS:

- Bring a resume and headshot
- Be prepared for a Q&A to discuss goals and past experiences

Primary interest in acting:

- Perform a one-minute monologue OR
- Perform a song and monologue, max. 90 seconds total, BUT
- Note that no accompanist will be provided, so students will need to bring their pre-recorded musical material to play on a phone or other device
- Be prepared to present a second, contrasting one-minute monologue if asked

Primary interest in design/technical theatre/stage management:

- Bring a portfolio with a selection of fine art and/or theatre work
- This can include (but is not limited to) production photographs of a student's design work, lighting plots, figure drawings, costume designs, 3-D set models, prompt books, etc.
- Be prepared to deliver a three-minute presentation about their resume

If you cannot make it on February 17, you may submit an online audition/portfolio.
